- Fred Couples and Fred Funk both have Champions Tour and PGA TOUR victories at The Woodlands Country Club Tournament Course;
- Defending champion, Bernhard Langer, matched the all-time low 54-hole score in Champions Tour history when he carded a 25-under-par 191 en route to winning his first of three Insuperity Invitational titles in 2007;
- There have been just two aces in the history of the Insuperity Invitational. Tom Kite aced the 16th hole in 2013, while J.L. Lewis made the first hole-in-one ever at the Insuperity Invitational in 2012 – also on the 16th hole.
