Things to Know

- Steve Stricker, Steven Alker and Brandt Jobe enter the final round with a share of the lead at the 2022 Insperity Invitational.
- The "3M Greats of Golf" 9-hole scramble was won by "The Greats," after **Jack Nicklaus** rolled in a birdie on No. 18 alongside his teammates **Lee Trevino**, **Gary Player** and **Annika Sörenstam**.

Steve Stricker, 67-65 - 132 (-12)

- In his first professional tournament since October 2021, he leads/co-leads entering the final round for the 10th time since joining PGA TOUR Champions in 2017
 - Most recent: won 2021 Bridgestone SENIOR PLAYERS Championship
 - 5-for-9 in converting leads into wins
- The Wisconsin native is tied with Brandt Jobe for most birdies (14) during rounds one and two
 - o Carded eight birdies before bogeying No. 18
- 55-year-old is seeking his eighth win on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Won twice in 2020-21, twice in 2019 and three times in 2018
- Finished T7 in his last outing on PGA TOUR Champions at Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS (October 10, 2021)
- Posted 11 top-10 finishes including two wins (2021 Chubb Classic; 2021 Bridgestone SENIOR PLAYERS Championship) in 13 events during 2020-21 season

Steven Alker, 67-65 - 132 (-12)

- This is his third time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions
 - 1-for-2 converting into victories (last: 2022 ClubCorp Classic/T2)
- Recorded his ninth consecutive below par round and his second-lowest 36-hole score (131/2021 Charles Schwab Cup Championship; 131/2021 TimberTech Championship)
 - Carded two eagles, five birdies and two bogeys during his second round
- One of two players (Vijay Singh) to card two eagles after two rounds
- Seeking his third PGA TOUR Champions win (2021 TimberTech Championship; 2022 Rapiscan Systems Classic)
- Finished T2 last week at the 2022 ClubCorp Classic after losing in a sudden-death playoff to Scott Parel
 - After last week's T2 finish, sits No. 2 with \$710, 961 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings

Posted four top-10 finishes in six starts during the 2022 season

Brandt Jobe, 68-64 – 132 (-12)

- Recorded a bogey-free 8-under 64, birdying the last six of seven holes entering the final round with a share of the lead
 - His 8-under 64 was the lowest round of the day
 - Ties his lowest second-round score (2017 3M Championship)
- This is his fourth time leading/co-leading entering the final round since joining PGA TOUR Champions in 2016
 - 1-for-3 converting into victories (2017 Principal Charity Classic)
- Tied with Steve Stricker for most birdies (14) after two rounds
- Seeking his third win on PGA TOUR Champions
 - o Last: 2019 Boeing Classic (2 years, 8 months, 5 days ago)
- Has posted two top-10 finishes in five starts this season

Other Notes

- **Ken Duke** is in fourth place after carding a bogey-free 6-under 66 round.
- Defending Champion Mike Weir sits T17 after carding 4-under 140.
- Wes Short, Jr. withdrew during the second round due to a back injury.
