Annika Sorenstam, Jack Nicklaus, Gary Player and Lee Trevino to Visit Media Center Saturday at 11 a.m. Media will have an opportunity to interview Annika Sorestam, Jack Nicklaus, Gary Player and Lee Trevino in the Media Center on Saturday, April 30, at 11 a.m. in advance of playing in the ninth annual 3M Greats of Golf competition.

The legendary foursome will be amongst a distinguished group of players who have combined for 232 PGA TOUR victories, 155 LPGA TOUR victories, 78 major championship titles, and 158 PGA TOUR Champions wins.

John Daly Goes Head to Head in Long Drive Competition against 12 Houston Area Residents

The Insperity Invitational will host a Grip It and Rip It Fuzzy's Vodka Outdrive John Daly Competition – giving 12 Houston area residents the chance to outdrive the two-time major winner on Friday, April 29 at The Woodlands Country Club Tournament Course.

Emceed by Fuzzy himself, the 12 contestants will each have three chances to outdrive John Daly on the driving range immediately following the former Insperity Invitational champion's opening round. Contestants hitting order will be determined during a meet and greet with Daly just prior to teeing it up. The contestant with the longest drive, who outdrives John Daly, will win a trip for two to play golf at Fuzzy Zoeller's home course in Southern Indiana and have dinner with Fuzzy. The trip includes airfare, lodging, golf and dinner with Fuzzy.

Contestants earned a spot in Friday's finals by winning one of a selection of local qualifiers held at public and private golf venues.

"I'm very excited to be back. I haven't played a PGA TOUR Champions event here yet, but I came to The Woodlands early on in my career and played here when the Tour was here in the 90s. So I'm excited to be here. I'm excited to be playing and excited to be playing competitively again. It's been a long road, but I'm feeling better and excited to be here."

"Just seeing the guys. The competition, too, is what I've missed also. These are a lot of the guys that I'm friends with and have grown up playing professionally with. I just literally got here, but I've seen a few of the guys already, and a few hugs. It's been a while since I've seen a lot of these guys. And a lot of them, to be quite honest, checked in with me

periodically throughout my whole ordeal, so that means a lot to see these guys. I can't wait to get out there."

"I don't know about my game is ready, but I'm ready to be here. I'm ready to be here physically. I've just got to see where I'm at and see how I feel, if I can put three days together on a golf course walking. I'm just trying to get the ball rolling. I'm just trying to see what I have, game, health, stamina, all that stuff. I come in here hoping to play well, I'm going to try to play well. That's the competitiveness in me, I guess."

"It's a nice golf course, interesting course. There's plenty of water on it. In terms of for my own game, takes the driver out of my hands a few too many times. The times you do hit the driver, you've got to do good off the tee here, you can do well. You can take the golf course on if you drive it well here. It breaks the back of the golf course if you drive it well, so that's kind of what you've got to do."

"It's amazing, most of the guys when they come back out here, they seem to reset who they are. They find their place, the same place that they probably had on the PGA TOUR they find out here again."

"I'm enjoying it out here. It's obviously a lot more relaxed. A few injuries, so I'm very happy that I can play in a cart and just take it a little easier during the week. 54 holes is good for me. "There's a lot of good things about being on the PGA TOUR Champions."

"You got to hole the putts. Hopefully, being out on this Tour I'll create more opportunities and start holing a few more putts and start feeling good about my putting."
