**PGA TOUR Champions Players to Compete for Record Sized Purse at 2025 Insperity Invitational
*Award-winning event in The Woodlands bumps purse to \$3 million, the highest ever for a non-major in

THE WOODLANDS, Texas— The stars of the PGA TOUR Champions will play for a record amount of money when they return to The Woodlands, Texas, April 28 – May 4, for the 2025 Insperity Invitational presented by UnitedHealthcare.

The award-winning event announced players will contest for the largest amount of prize money in a non-major event on the PGA TOUR Champions at \$3 million (team events excluded).
